- (b) Councillor Ingram advised that he had spoken with the Belchers about their gateway. He confirmed that they were happy for the Parish Council to include this in their maintenance programme

056/24 Opportunity for County/Borough Councillors/members of the public to speak

County Councillor Orson apologised for not attending as many meetings as he would like. He has 14 Parish Councils within the County and tries to attend two or three a month. The Clerk advised that now the road was open all the notice boards in the villages would be updated.
