011/23 Road Survey Work around the Parish of Burton and Dalby

The Clerk had forwarded to Councillors a number of dates when the survey work could be undertaken in May but it was proving a little problematic with the continuing road works on Melton Road, Burton Lazars and the availability of equipment. Councillors expressed concern about data being collected during half term week when the volume of traffic would be considerably less. The Clerk was requested to enquire if the works could be undertaken in June.

012/23 QR Codes

Discussions were held about the accessing of specific landmarks via QR Codes to enable both residents and visitors to engage with the Parish of Burton and Dalby. Councillor Johnson will develop this concept before the next meeting when it will be discussed further as part of the Parish Council's 2023/2024 projects.

013/23 Coronation Celebrations for King Charles III

- (a) Update from Burton Lazars Group. The event held on Sunday 7th May had been successful. Prior to the meeting, the Clerk had forwarded to Councillors a list of expenditure which was within the budget of £2,000 agreed by the Parish Council. It was proposed by Councillor Blewett and seconded by Councillor Johnson that the monies, in the sum of £1,450.04, are re-imbursed.
- (b) Update from Great Dalby Group. The events held over the weekend had been successful. Prior to the events, a request had been received for an increase to the initial budget of £1,000 to £2,000. Councillors agreed to this request via email. It was proposed by

Councillor Wilkinson and seconded by Councillor Watson that the monies, in the sum of £1,445.98 are re-imbursed.

Councillor Blewett advised that he had been in communication with OMNI regarding the activities for Summer 2023. It was proposed by Councillor Blewett and seconded by Councillor Davies that the Parish Council subsidise the costs to the sum of £4,500.00. The Parish Council agreed that OMNI could decide if the event was run for a two or three week period and the individual cost per child.

Councillor Johnson:

An area on a piece of the grass verge between Top End and Main Street, Great Dalby, which is maintained by Leicestershire Highways, has red plastic gating around it and has been taped off. This is affecting the cutting of the grass and is a possible sight obstruction to motorists. There is no indication as to who has taped the area off.
